RE: CMAQ 2020 Fund Balance

This Intergovernmental Agreement with the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) for Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) federal grant is for \$850,647.

As a result of the recent bid for 8th Street & Bridge Street for a total of \$262,846, there remains a balance of \$587,801.

Balances for PM-10 maintenance will no longer be rolled forward and all funds must be encumbered by September 2020. Funds may not be encumbered until a design is complete and environmental clearance has been completed. CDOT is committed to helping us meet that deadline and encouraging us to choose another paving project that can quickly be designed and have as few clearance issues as possible.

You may recall that last July we had a discussion about site selection including the pros and cons of each potential project site.

The criteria for which staff selects potential projects includes a number of factors. First we look at traffic volume. Those streets with the highest traffic counts generate the most dust. Next to be considered are utilities with current critical utility issues being water, gas, and stormwater (All current water capital funding is tied up in other priority projects. There are no available stormwater capital funds except the COP proceeds which are already dedicated to other project sites. Atmos Energy has a 5-year capital project plan to replace gas lines that is not yet underway.) Further evaluation is done based on other characteristics of the road that would impact environmental clearance such as necessary right-of-way and easements, ditch crossings, and historical neighborhoods. Finally we review the volume of complaints and maintenance demands.

In reviewing the list of potential project sites and the mentioned criteria, the following sites are recommended for the balance in 2020:
