1. **Call to Order:** 4 PM by Chairman Chris Jenkins
2. **Attendance (Roll Call) Present:** Chris Jenkins, Rich Millard, Jim Nelson, Mike Madone, Lester Limon, Mildred Wintz, Loren Flick **Staff:** Museum & History Center Director Lisa Studts, Economic Development Director Rick Harrmann; **Guests:** City Council Member Amy Schmisser, HPC Volunteer Aaron Malejko
3. **Approval of Minutes:** Minutes of the 26, 2023 meeting were corrected by Lester changing item 5c's 4th word from "who" to "how" and approved on Lester's motion, seconded by Millie. Chris, Rich, Loren, Lester, and Millie voted Yay; Mike and Jim abstained since they were not at the meeting.
4. **Subcommittee Updates**
 - Public Outreach Committee**
 - a. Lisa noted that, due to a permanent scheduling conflict, the Public Outreach Committee could not meet prior to this meeting at its previous location adjacent to the meeting room. There was a brief discussion about meeting at the Museum & History Center but, due to the needed travel time to attend the 4PM HPC meeting, the Commission asked staff to explore other meeting room options at City Hall – possibly across the lower lobby.
 - b. Lisa said there was a full historic bicycle tour of Lakeside Cemetery on July 12th and another tour is planned on August 23rd of the Riverwalk with registration now open online. She said there will be a Downtown Historic Walking Tour on July 29th at 10 AM, slots for the tour are open and registration is available online: https://museum.canoncity.org/?tribe_events=historic-downtown-walking-tout-pt-ii . A tour of Greenwood Cemetery is being

developed and will be held in late October. Museum staff is also developing an exhibit on area schools, which should be opening in the Fall.

- c. Jim brought up the Creative Crosswalks project recently announced on the City's website: <https://www.canoncity.org/562/Creative-Crosswalks> . This might provide a fun and interesting way to draw the public's attention to downtown history. Proposals are due by August 11th, so we will need to quickly discuss possibilities if this is of interest.

- d. Lisa distributed a list of Subdivisions dating back to 1872 that is being compiled into an interactive map with the aid of the City's GIS staff. Aaron has also been assisting with this project. Lisa hopes to have a sample available at the next meeting.
