

Attachment H: Bowling Alleys and Movie Theaters

If bowling alleys and movie theatres so choose, they can open to provide limited services if they can strictly adhere to social distancing guidelines. Bowling alleys and movie theatres must take the necessary time to ensure each of the following is adequately addressed before opening to the public.

- Customers or patrons should be asked about symptoms before entering or participating in the activity, and service or participation should be declined if they are symptomatic.
- Limit number of customers by only utilizing every other lane in the bowling alley setting and by utilizing every other row and by separating groups within a row by leaving a space of 3 empty seats between groups in the movie theatre setting.
- The movie theatres should have some form of staggered exiting when the movie is complete
- Every other urinal to be available in men's restroom
- Limit group size to six people or members of the same household.
- Encourage customers not to wait in the lobby area or lines outside of the door, implement a reservation system, notify customers via text/call when their lane is ready.
- Place markings on the floor to mark 6 ft distances at concession areas and counters to ensure proper social distancing.
- Post signs at entrances regarding face coverings, and post signs throughout the facility as needed to remind customers of social distancing and proper hygiene.
- Require customers to wear cloth face coverings.
- Make reasonable accommodations for vulnerable populations who are still under the Stay at Home advisement. (e.g. seating assistance, special hours)
- Ask customers if they are experiencing any symptoms prior to allowing them to enter, do not allow them to enter if they are.
- Gaming areas such as arcades shall remain closed.
- Implement one-way entry/exit and directional walkways as much as possible.
- Limit the number of people exiting the theatre at one time to avoid crowding
- Perform environmental cleaning and disinfection of bathrooms and high touch surfaces every 2 hours and maintain a cleaning log.
- Limit restrooms to the use of every other urinal/stall
- Staff handling food and drinks shall wear gloves.
- Staff handling dirty dishes must wear gloves and an apron.
- Tables and seating are to be sanitized between customers.
- Bowling balls and shoes shall be sanitized between each use.
- Staff must wash and/or sanitize their hands between each customer.
- Theatres shall limit or allow enough time between show times to allow for proper sanitization of the theatre, bathrooms and concession areas.
- The bar/lounge areas will remain closed
- Monitor employees for one of the following symptoms:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath/difficulty breathingOr two or more of the following symptoms:
 - Fever
 - Chills

Repeated shaking with Chills

Muscle Pain

Headache

Sore throat

New loss of taste or smell

Symptomatic employees MUST be excluded from the workplace

- Employees and contracted workers shall be required to wear a non-medical cloth face covering over the nose and mouth, individuals who cannot wear a mask shall not be permitted to work at this time.
- Implement or maintain physical barriers for high-contact settings. (e.g. Cashiers)
- Implement touchless payment methods where possible.
- Stagger shifts if feasible to decrease employee numbers at the business.
