Comparisons by Demographic Subgroups

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Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by annual household income and age.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as “excellent” or “good,” or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A “p-value” of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are “real.” Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for all respondents (558 completed surveys) is generally no greater than plus or minus four percentage points around any given percent. The margin of error for subgroups is less precise. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Within Community Characteristics, residents who were age 18-44 tended to give less positive ratings to Safety and to Education and Enrichment, as well as to general aspects, than those who were older.
- Residents that earned less than \$50,000 per year were more likely to positively rate the overall appearance of Cañon City than those who earned more, whereas residents earning \$100,000 or more tended to give higher marks to their neighborhood as a place to live. Those who earned \$50,000 to \$99,999 were more pleased with the city as a place to raise children and to retire than other residents.
- Residents age 55 or older tended to give higher ratings than younger residents to some of the services related to Built Environment (sewer services, power utility and utility billing).
- Residents who were 18-44 years of age were more likely to have reported a crime or have been the victim of a crime.
- Residents who earned at least \$50,000 per year were more likely to participate in aspects of Community Engagement than those who earned less.
- Residents who earned \$100,000 or more or were age 55 or older were less likely than their counterparts to support some of the prospective new efforts identified in Cañon City’s unique questions.
