# About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey™, the City of Cañon City conducted a mailed survey of 1,600 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in June 2018 and data were collected through July. After the official data collection period was underway (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Cañon City, CO, 2018*), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey during late July 2018 and 275 surveys were received. Responses from those who indicated they did not live in Cañon City were removed, resulting in a total of 216 completed surveys.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey that have not been weighted to current population estimates of Cañon City.
